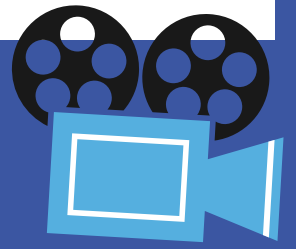




# THE GIRL WHO WORE **FREEDOM**

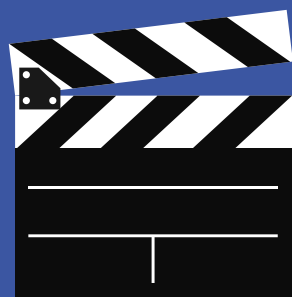
3. After you register and make the donation, you will receive a PayPal receipt.
